

TENNESSEE 4-H PHOTO SEARCH GENERAL RULES

1. Any junior high or senior 4-H member may submit entries. Photos must be taken by the member making the entry.
 2. Each entry will consist of:
 - * a print (no larger than 5 x 7) and the negative,
 - * a color slide,
 - * or a print (no larger than 5 x 7) and a diskette/CD containing the photo in a digital format.
- Prints need not be provided of a color slide. **DO NOT CLIP INDIVIDUAL NEGATIVES FROM THE STRIP.** Submit the entire strip and indicate the negative number on the entry form. An individual may submit multiple entries on a single diskette/CD as long as each entry is clearly identified and matched with its entry form.
3. A completed entry form must accompany each Photo Search entry.
 4. Photos should relate to 4-H involvement. Entries may be a single photo or a series of not more than four (4) photos. A series may be “before and after” or “how-to-do-it” sequences.
 5. Entries will be judged on quality and message. The photos might depict:
 - * 4-H project work
 - * 4-H exhibits, shows, fairs, etc.
 - * 4-H leadership/citizenship
 - * Leisure education, camp, etc.
 - * Human interest and other
