

# **NATIONAL 4-H CONFERENCE**

National 4-H Conference is an opportunity for 4-H members to work together to influence 4-H direction and policy on the National Level.

## **Location and Date**

National 4-H Conference takes place at the National 4-H Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland (near Washington D.C.). The Conference is an eight day event which takes place in mid April.

## **Specialists**

The State 4-H Staff will actively participate in this event. Steve Sutton will usually serve as events coordinator and handle all arrangements for the Tennessee delegation.

## **Eligibility**

To participate in the National 4-H Conference, a 4-H member must be a member of the State 4-H Council. *See Roundup and Region and State Officers.*

## **Cost**

The cost for each delegate is \$200 (this amount is subject to change; check with Region Office for current amount).

## **Transportation**

Agents and delegates will receive a transportation schedule from the State Office prior to the event. This schedule will inform agents as to when and where delegates are to meet the bus.

## **Agent Assignment**

Due to the limited number of delegates participating in this event, no agents are assigned to attend.
