Step 3 Putting it together

- 4 Posters outlining your demo.
- Equipment and Materials
- All materials must fit in a small box which can be carried by 4-H'er.
- 14 x 22 is best... can be on poster board or foam core.

Method Poster

- Step 1. Cut wood to plan
- Step 2. Arrange Parts
- Step 3. Hammer Parts
- Step 4. Sand along edges
- Step 5. Paint

Remember:

- Saw wood under supervision of adult.
- Arrange all pieces before nailing.
- Use a water based paint.
